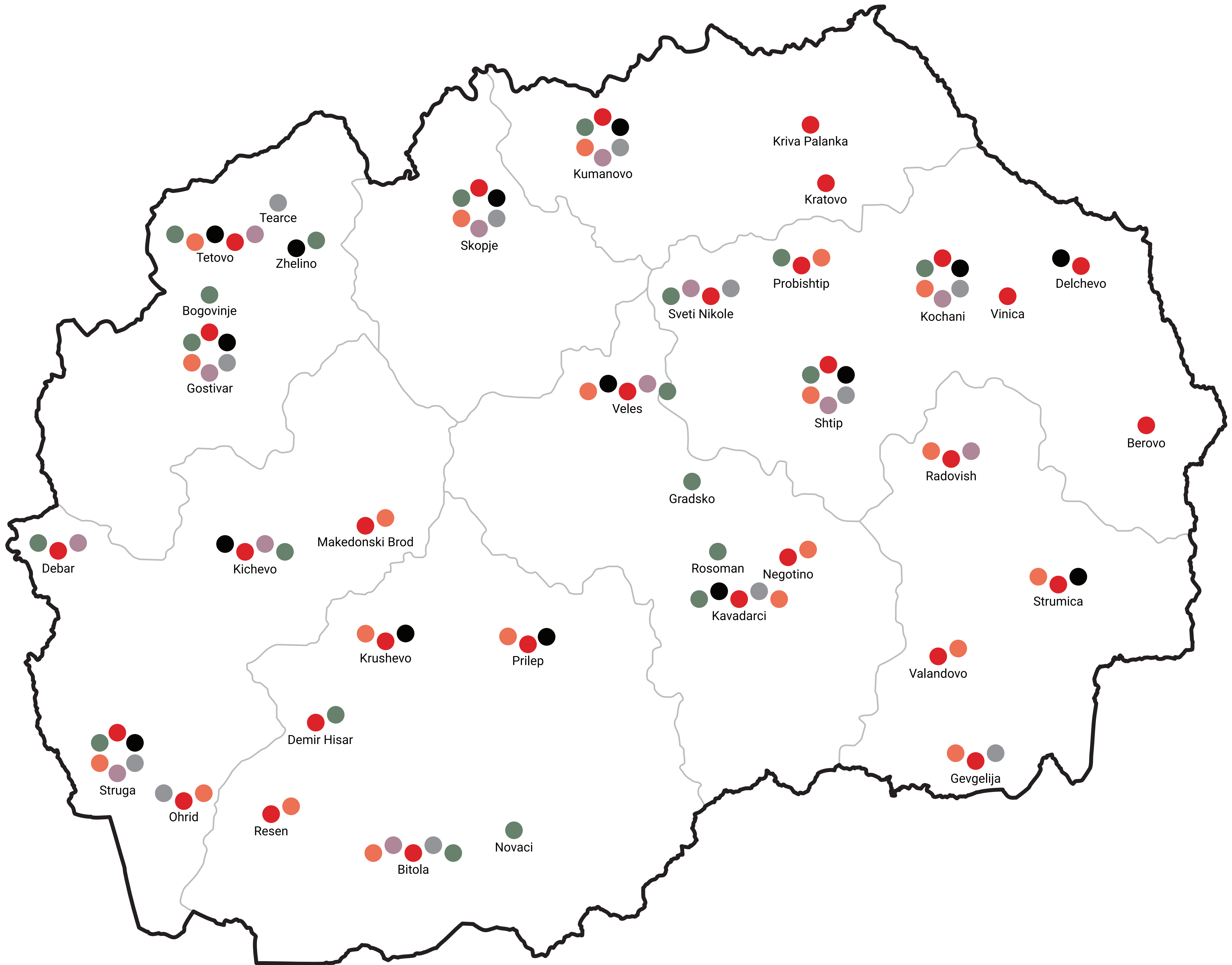

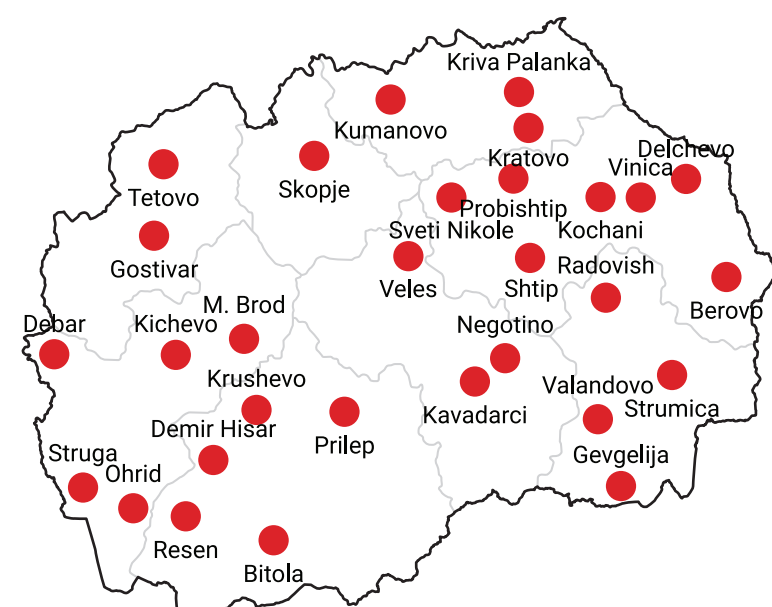

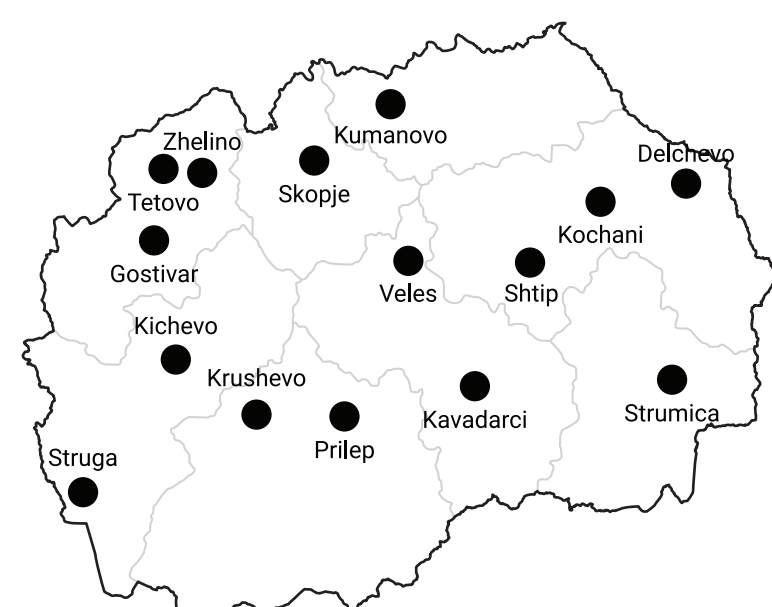
1. HEADQUARTERS AND REGIONAL OFFICES OF THE SEC

Capacity building events and technical support provided to the State Election Commission's Headquarters and 34 Regional Offices.



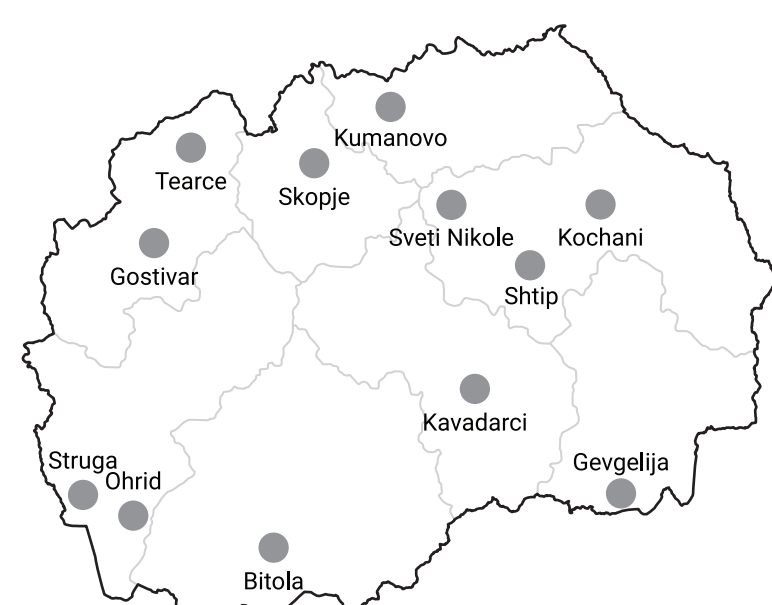
2. ACADEMY FOR PUBLIC POLICY

45 political party youth conducted innovative initiatives to engage and communicate with citizens on issues of concern and discuss possible solutions to be offered by parties for the next elections.



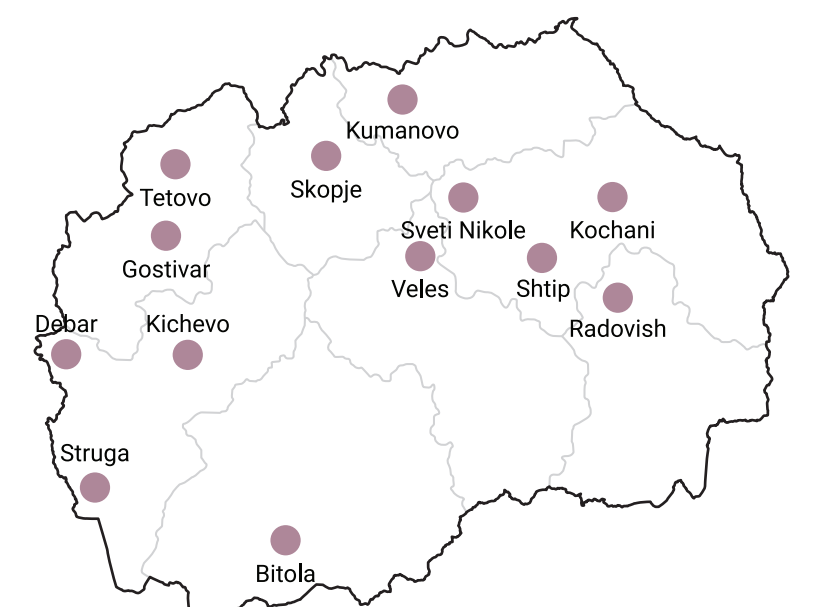
3. TOWN HALL DISCUSSIONS

Outreach activities organized at a local level to engage with citizens, identify their pressing needs and concerns, facilitate communication with party candidates and elected officials and discuss possible solutions.



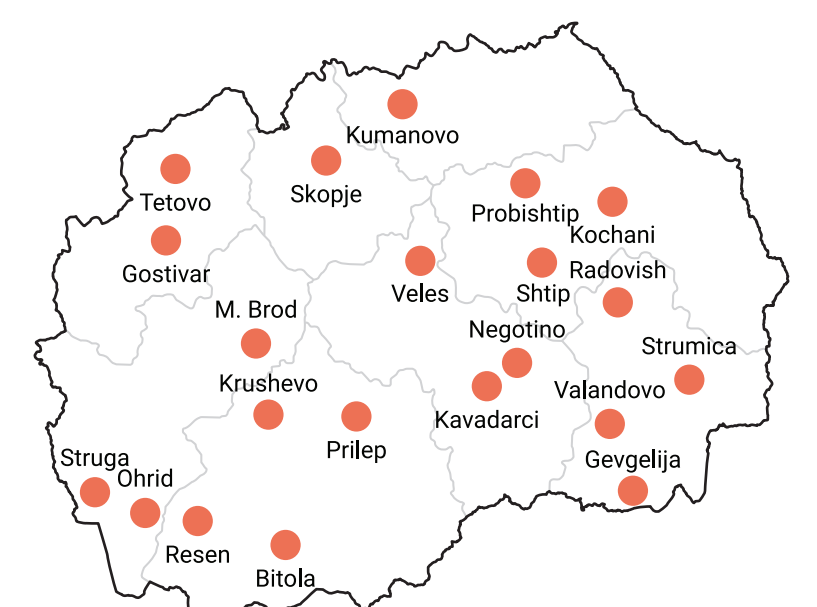
4. CRASH COURSES FOR POLITICAL PARTIES AND INDEPENDENT CANDIDATES

Training events aimed at strengthening the capacities of smaller political parties, groups of voters and independent candidates to meet election-related legal requirements.



5. COMMUNITY MOBILIZERS

40 community mobilizers trained to conduct monitoring activities of government promises and implement innovative initiatives to inform and galvanize local communities.



6. DEMOGRAPHIC REPORT

Presentation of the Report on the Demographic Effects on Civic Engagement and Voter Education, aimed at strengthening the effectiveness of election campaigns and raising awareness of the importance of socio-political participation and civic activism.
